



A Law That is Not Broken

Galatians 6:7-8

“Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap. [8] For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life.”



“Don’t Be Deceived”

- The devil tries to deceive
 - Pretends to be what he is not (2 Cor. 11:13-15).
 - Lies (Gen. 3:4-5)
 - Promises but doesn’t deliver (2 Pet. 2:19)



God is not mocked

Greek work for mocked
(mukterizo) means “to turn
up nose, to sneer at, to mock,
to deride.”



He who sows to the flesh *(let the lower nature have its way)*

- To sow to the flesh is to pander to it, to cuddle and stroke it, instead of crucifying it.
Every time we:
 - Harbor a grudge, nurse a grievance, or wallow in self-pity
 - Linger in bad company
 - Every time we read pornographic literature
 - Every time we take a risk which strains our self-control, we are sowing, sowing, sowing to the flesh.
- Reap corruption (2 Thess. 1:7-9)



He who sows to the Spirit
(Let the Holy Spirit have His way)

- To sow to the spirit means to:
 - Meditate upon the Spirit's words (Psa. 1)
 - Walk in the Spirit (Gal. 5:16) or according to the Spirit's direction
 - Be filled with the Spirit (Eph. 5:18)
 - Live in such a way that we don't grieve the Spirit (Eph. 4:30)



He who sows to the Spirit
(Let the Holy Spirit have His way)

- Note the difference of what it will produce
(Gal. 5:19-26)
- When we do, we'll reap, everlasting life
(Matt. 25:46)
