



Jesus Fulfilled the Purpose of the Law

- By demonstrating the standard of righteousness
 - Matthew 3:15
 - But Jesus answered and said to him, "Permit it to be so now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness." Then he allowed Him.



*By Demonstrating
the Standard of Righteousness*

■ **Hebrews 4:15**

- For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.



By Demonstrating the Standard of Righteousness

■ Hebrews 7:26-28

- For such a High Priest was fitting for us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and has become higher than the heavens; [27] who does not need daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for His own sins and then for the people's, for this He did once for all when He offered up Himself. [28] For the law appoints as high priests men who have weakness, but the word of the oath, which came after the law, appoints the Son who has been perfected forever.



By Demonstrating the Standard of Righteousness

- **1 Peter 2:22**
 - **Who committed no sin, Nor was deceit found in His mouth**
- **2 Cor. 5:21**
 - **For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.**
- **John 8:46**
 - **Which of you convicts Me of sin? And if I tell the truth, why do you not believe Me?**



Jesus Fulfilled the Purpose of the Law

- ***By declaring the exceeding sinfulness of sin***
 - **Romans 7:13**
 - **Has then what is good become death to me? Certainly not! But sin, that it might appear sin, was producing death in me through what is good, so that sin through the commandment might become exceedingly sinful.**



Jesus fulfilled the Purpose of the Law

- ***By fulfilling the Law's righteous sentence***
 - He received the penalty for sin by dying as a sin offering
 - Romans 3:24-26
 - being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, [25] whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed, [26] to demonstrate at the present time His righteousness, that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.



He Received the Penalty for Sin by Dying As a Sin Offering

- Galatians 3:13
 - Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree").
- 1 Peter 2:24
 - Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.



Jesus fulfilled the Purpose of the Law

- **By fulfilling O.T. prophecies**
 - Defeat of Satan
 - "And I will put enmity
 - Between you and the woman
 - And between your seed and her Seed
 - He shall bruise your head
 - And you shall bruise His heel. (Gen. 3:15)



By Fulfilling O.T. Prophecies

- The Prophet
 - "The Lord your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your midst, from your brethren. Him you shall hear; (Deut. 18:15)
 - Fulfilled (Acts 3:22-23)



By Fulfilling O.T. Prophecies

- Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace
 - For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace (Isa. 9:6)
 - Fulfilled (The Gospels)
