





**Five Views of Mark 16:16**

**Mark 16:16**

**believe will be condemned.”**




**Mark 16:16**

**View of Atheists**




**Mark 16:16**

**View of Universalists**




**Mark 16:16**

condemned.”**


**View of Believers**



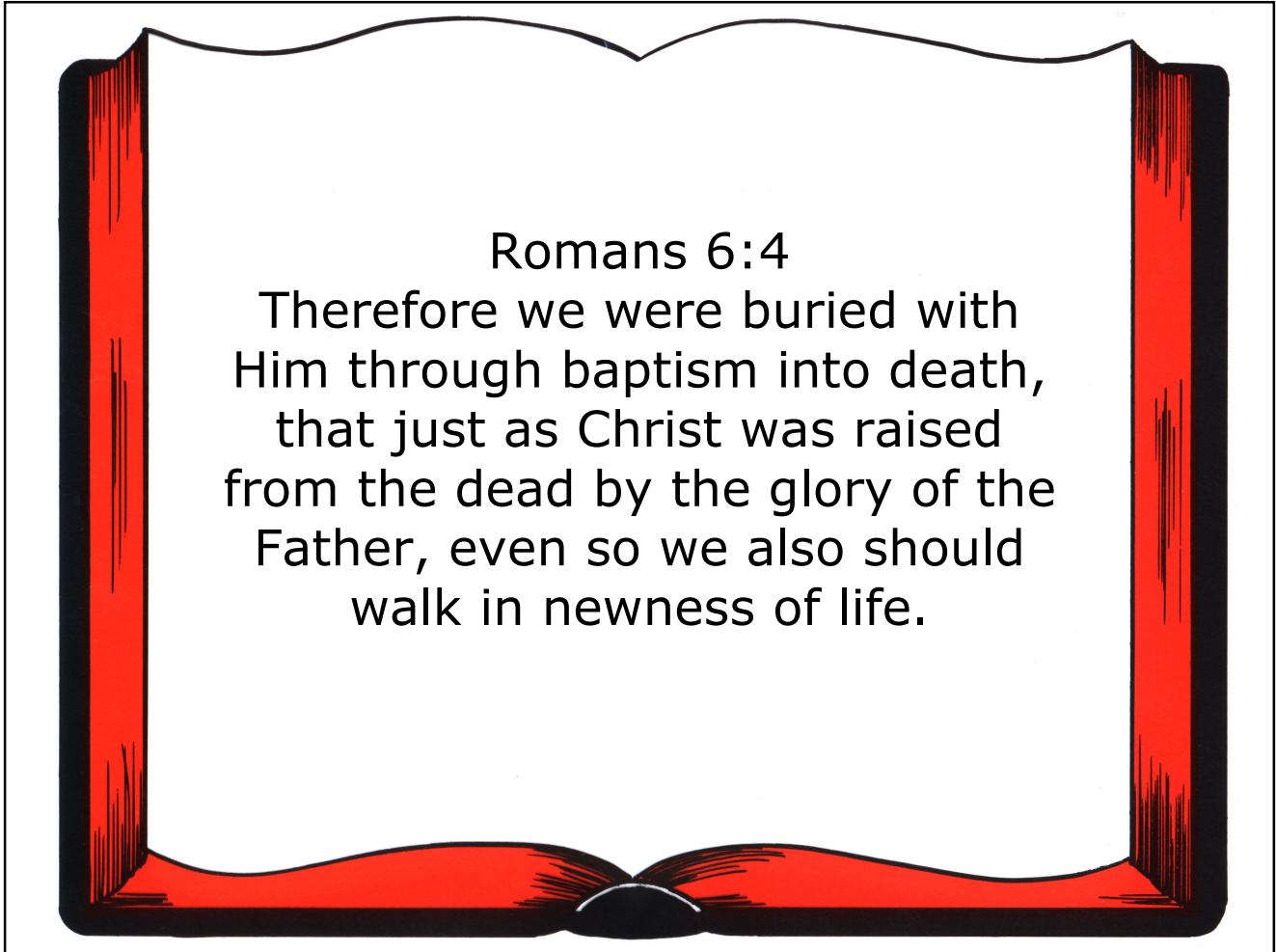
**This view is in harmony with other passages. Consider:**

the Holy Spirit."

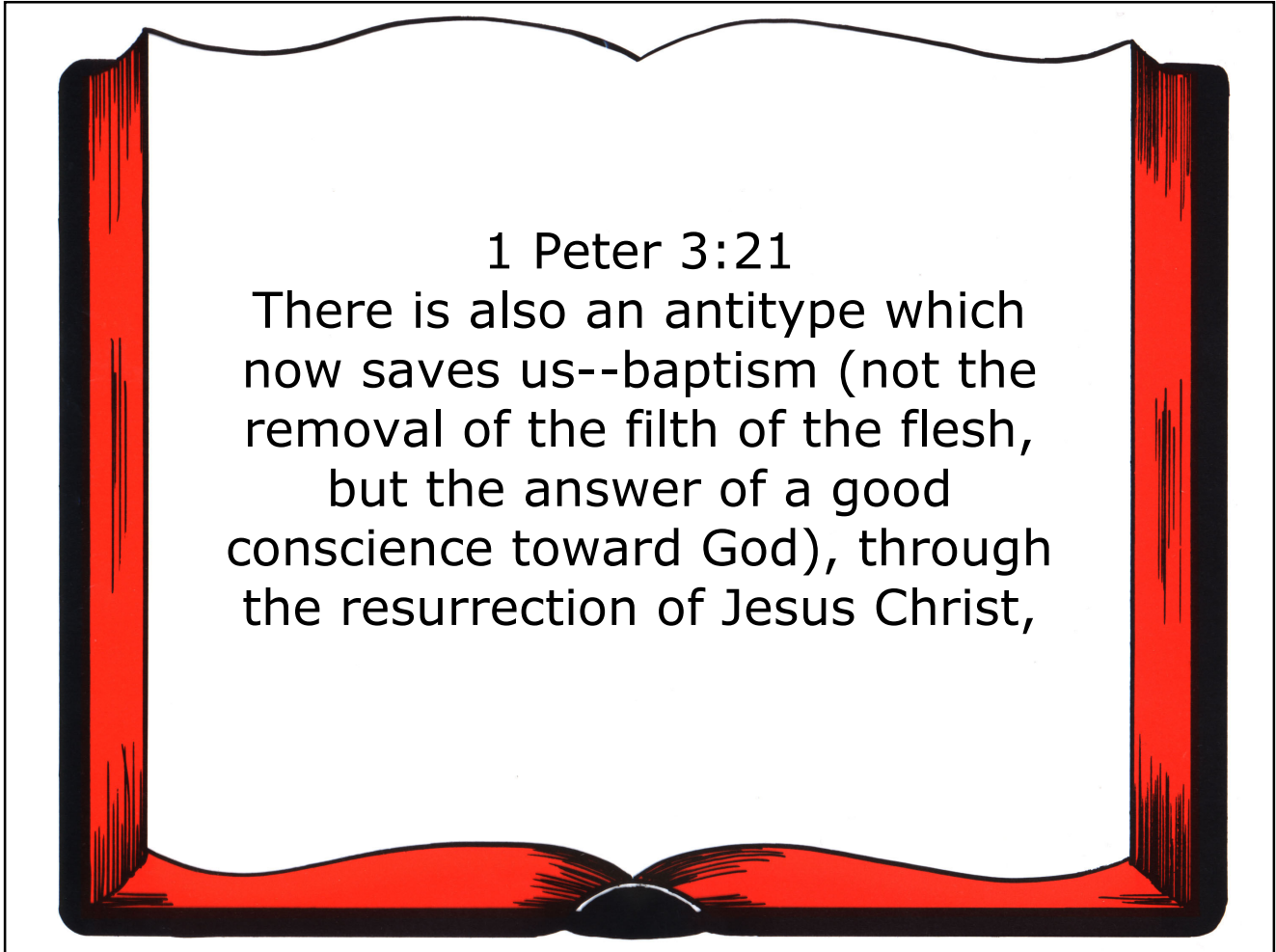


Acts 22:16
