

Their Attitude

- “ We Don’t need God”
 - The wicked in his proud countenance does not seek God; God is in none of his thoughts. (v. 4) ...He has said in his heart, “I shall not be moved; I shall never be in adversity.” Psalms 10:4, 6, NKJV.

Their Attitude

- “God won’t see MY sins”
 - He has said in his heart, “God has forgotten; He hides His face; He will never see.” Psalms 10:11, NKJV.

Their Attitude

- “God won’t hold me accountable”
 - Why do the wicked renounce God? He has said in his heart, “You will not require an account.” (Psalm 10:13)

They thought: We don't need God!

- What about us?
 - Sometimes our actions show that we think the same!
 - When we neglect our salvation (Heb. 2:1-3)
 - When we hold just a form of godliness (2 Tim. 3:4)
 - When our knowledge becomes stagnate (2 Tim. 3:7)
 - When we forsake the assembling together (Heb. 10:24-25)
 - When we are inactive (1 Cor. 15:58)

They thought: they could hide their sin

What about us?

- Remember that God is an all seeing God (Heb. 4:11-13)
- Remember Ananias & Sapphira (Acts 5:1-10)
- Remember our conscience

They thought: God wouldn't bring them into judgment.

What about us?

- Need to remember that God's time table is not the same as ours (2 Pet. 3:8-9)
- That God fulfills His promises (Heb. 2:2)
- Judgment is sure (2 Cor. 5:10; Heb. 9:27)
