- ◆ With an unforgiving heart (Matt. 6:14, 15)



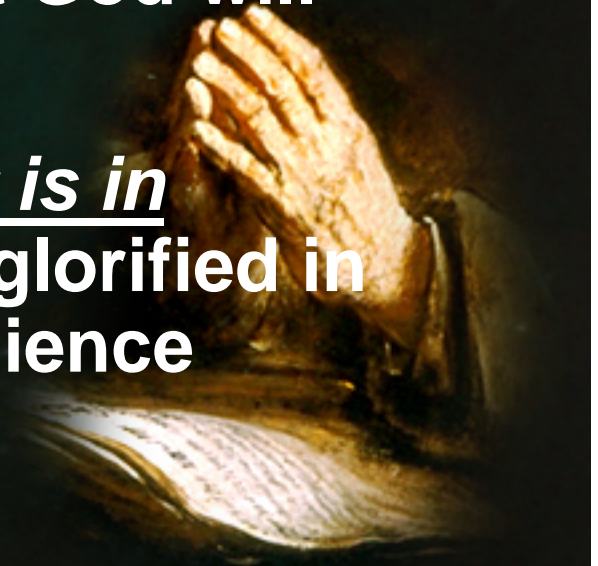
He Says to Pray
