- Elijah (Mal. 4:5-6; Matt. 11:11-15)
- Jeremiah (Jno. 11:35; Matt. 23:37)

# What If We Ask That Question Today?

- ◆ The Moslem would say, “He was a prophet, but ‘They do blaspheme who say:’ Allah is Christ the son of Mary...” (Surah 5:75)
- ◆ The Jehovah Witnesses would say, “He is a god, but not God.”
- ◆ Believers of the Eastern religions would give a variety of answers.

# “Whom Do You Say That I Am?”

- ◆ “Thou art the Christ”
- ◆ “Son of God”
  - ◆ “Son of” means that He was of the same nature as God, the Father (Col. 1:15; Heb. 1:1-3)
  - ◆ Eternal (Jno. 1:1, 14)
  - ◆ “God manifested in the flesh” (1 Tim. 3:16)
  - ◆ Immanuel (God with us) (Matt. 1:23)
