- A Prepared place (Jno. 14:1-3)
- A rest (Heb. 4:1, 9-10)
- A place of true freedom from:
 - Sickness and death (Rev. 21:4)
 - Temptation and sin (Rev. 22:3)
 - The wicked (Rev. 21:27)
- Eternal (Matt. 25:46)

What kind of preparation?

- More than being good (Acts 10:2)
- More than being religious (Acts 2, 9, 16, 19)
- Takes God's Grace (Eph. 2:8)
- Takes acceptance of His grace by faith (Eph. 2:8)

Worse than death

“Anyone who has rejected Moses' law *dies without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses. Of how much worse punishment*, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot,...It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.”

Everlasting Fire

Mark 9:43
