What is fellowship?

- The word “fellowship” is translated from the Greek word, “Koinonia” which means a communion, fellowship, sharing in common

What is walking in the light?

- **It is walking**
 - With the Right attitude toward sin (1:8; 3:9)
 - Admit it (1:8)
 - Don't live in it (3:9)
 - Keeping the Commandments (2:3-6)
 - Like Jesus (Heb. 5:7-9)
 - Loving Brethren (2:8-11; 3:14-18)
 - With the right attitude toward Jesus (2:22-23)
 - Without the love of the world (2:15-17)
- **More than just a step – it's a life (3:9)**
