Why Aren't All Converted?

- All want to be lost? No!
- The real reason – They don't want to change
 - Repentance is a change of heart produced by “godly sorrow” (2 Cor. 7:10)
- “Godly sorrow” is when we are sorry that we sinned against God!
 - Who made us (Col. 1:16)
 - Who loves us (Rom. 5:8)
 - Who wants us to be saved (2 Pet. 3:9)
