  - Conviction (Acts 26:26-27)
  - Fear (Acts 24:24-25)
  - Sorrow (2 Cor. 7:10)

# WHAT IS REPENTANCE?

- The Greek word, "Metanoio" means a change of mind.
- Example - Prodigal Son (Lk. 15)
- Summary (Isa. 55:7)

Let the wicked forsake his way,  
And the unrighteous man his thoughts;  
Let him return to the Lord,  
And He will have mercy on him;  
And to our God  
For He will abundantly pardon.

# WHAT IS REPENTANCE?

- A change of mind (Lk. 15; Isa. 55:7)
  - Produced by godly sorrow (2 Cor. 7:10)
- Brings forth a change of life (Acts 19:19)

# WHY SHOULD WE REPENT?

- Godly sorrow (Psa. 51)
- God's goodness (Rom. 2:4; 2 Pet. 3:9)
- To be saved (Acts 2:38)
- Judgment (Acts 17:30, 31)

# WILL YOU REPENT?

- Depends
  - Is there godly sorrow in your heart?
  - Do you appreciate the goodness of God?
  - Can you picture yourself on judgment day?
