“Walk as Children of Light” (Eph. 5:8)

- He reminds us that we were in darkness (2 Cor. 4:4; Isa. 5:20)
- Why so bad?
 - Domain of Satan (Col. 1:13)
 - Brings God’s penalty (Eph. 5:6)
 - Leads to eternal darkness (Matt. 8:12)
 - We can get used to the Darkness

“Walk as Children of Light” (Eph. 5:8)

- He reminds us of what we ought to be (5:9)
 - All goodness (1 Thess. 5:15)
 - Righteousness (1 Jno. 2:29)
 - Truth (Jno. 8:32)

“Walk as Children of Light” (Eph. 5:8)

- He Warns Us (5:11-12)
 - Don't fellowship darkness, but reprove – sometimes direct – sometimes indirect
 - Don't even speak of the things done in secret
- He Calls Us to Action (5:14)
 - Awake sleeper

I heard the voice of Jesus say,
“I am this dark world’s light;
Look unto Me, thy morn shall rise,
And all thy day be bright.”
I looked to Jesus, and I found
In Him my star, my sun;
And in that light of life I’ll walk,
