# Isaiah realized three things:

---

- ❖ **On his own he was lost:** *“Woe is me.”*
- ❖ **He was lost because he had sinned:** *“I am a man of unclean lips.”*
- ❖ **He was among other sinners:** *“I live among a people of unclean lips.”* (In other words, *“I’m just like the rest of them!”*)

**Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a live coal *which* he had taken with the tongs from the altar. 7 And he touched my mouth *with it*, and said:**

**Behold, this has touched your lips;  
Your iniquity is taken away,  
And your sin purged." (Isa. 6:6-7)**
