Risen with the Lord

- Death of the Lord
 - Why did he have to die?
 - God's plan for mankind (1 Cor 2:7-8)
 - Sacrifice required because of sin (Heb 9:13-14, 1 Cor 1:7)
 - To Restore man to God (Heb 9:15, Rom 8:3-5)
 - Love (John 3:16)

Risen with the Lord

- Death of the Lord
 - Why did he have to die?
 - Burial of the Lord
 - Christ spoke of it (Matt 12:40-41, Mark 8:31-32)
 - Prophets spoke of it (Psalm 16:10, Isaiah 53:9)
 - Prepared the body (Luke 23:53, John 19:39)
 - Believed burial was permanent (Mark 16:1-4)

Risen with the Lord

- Burial WITH the Lord
 - Spiritual Death
 - Sin separates (Rom 6:23)
 - Death to the old sinful self (Rom 6:5-8)
 - Death to the call of the world (1 John 2:15-17, James 4:4)
 - Crucified with the Lord (Gal 2:20)

Risen with the Lord

- Burial WITH the Lord
 - Spiritual Death
 - Burial in a watery grave
 - Baptism (Rom 6:4, Col 2:11-14)
 - A burial to save (1 Pet 3:21-22)

Risen with the Lord

- His Resurrection

- Risen Lord Confirmed

- Women at the tomb (Luke 24:6, John 20:18)
 - Disciples (John 20:3-9)
 - Thomas (John 20:28)
 - >500 (1 Cor 15:6)

Risen with the Lord

- His Resurrection
 - Risen Lord Confirmed
 - Jesus Conquered Death
 - Predicted from Eden (Gen 3:15)
 - Cornerstone of our faith (1 Cor 15:17-19)
 - Source of our hope (Titus 1:2)

Risen with the Lord

- My Resurrection
 - Into a new way of life (Rom 6:4, 8:1-2)
 - Reconciled with God (2 Cor 5:17-19)
 - Resurrected into a purpose (Eph 2:10)
 - Victory! (1 Cor 15:56-57)
