

“Let Us...”

- Fear lest we miss the promised rest (Heb. 4:1)
- Pray boldly to find grace to help in time of need (Heb. 4:16)
- Grow unto perfection (Heb. 6:1)
- Draw near to God with a true heart (Heb. 10:22)
- Run with endurance the race before us (Heb. 12:1)

Heb 13:10-15

- “We have an altar from which those who serve the tabernacle have no right to eat...Therefore **let us go forth to Him**, outside the camp, bearing His reproach...Therefore by Him **let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God**, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name.”

What should be our response?

- **Let us go forth to Him (Heb. 13:13)**
 - *Partake of the altar – the sacrifice and teachings of Jesus*
 - Don't partake of the strange doctrines – v. 9
 - John 6:51-58 teaches the same thing!

How should we respond?

- Let us go forth to Him (Heb. 13:13)
 - “*Outside the camp*”
 - When we do, it *may* mean:
 - Alienation (Matt. 10:34-39)
 - Persecution (Matt. 5:3-12)

How should we respond?

- Let us go forth to Him (Heb. 13:13)
 - “*Outside the camp*”
 - When we do, it *will* mean:
 - Sanctification (1 Pet. 4:1-5)
 - Relationship (1 Pet. 2:9-10)

How should we respond?

- **Seek the continuing city – the one to come!**
- **Offer the sacrifice of praise to God
(Heb. 13:15)**
