# **“God Wants Me to be Happy!”**

- **What’s wrong with that statement?**
  - **It’s selfish**
  - **It’s ignorant**
    - **Of God’s real joy found in the right character (Matt. 5:1-12)**
    - **Of the consequences of sin (Gal. 6:7-8)**
  - **It’s destructive (Matt. 19:9 – Rev. 21:8)**

# **“Doesn’t Matter What We Believe!”**

- **Was Jesus wrong when He condemned the Pharisees? (Mk. 7:1-13; 21-23)**
- **Was Paul wrong when he condemned the Judaizers? (Gal. 3:1-3; 5:4; 1:7-9)**
- **Was John wrong when he condemned those who rejected Christ? (2 Jno. 9-10)**

## **“Accept Christ as Your Personal Savior!”**

- **True, He is a personal Savior.**
  - **But they mean: just pray a prayer...**
    - **Paul prayed and wasn't saved (Acts 22:16)**
    - **Cornelius prayed (Acts 10:2; 5, 6)**
  - **Christians are told to pray; but not alien sinners (1 Jno. 1:7-9)**
